**RE: Changes to your prescription for Fostair pressurised metered dose inhaler (pMDI)**

Our records show that you are currently prescribed a Fostair brand of pMDI.

NHS Dorset have asked all GP practices to review the prescribing of Fostair-branded inhalers and convert patients to the preferred Proxor or Bibecfo brands of pMDI inhalers.

Proxor and Bibecfo pMDI contain the same medicines (Beclometasone + Formoterol) in the same quantities as Fostair pMDI but are first choice brands on the Dorset medicines formulary.

Proxor and Bibecfo use the same inhaler technique as Fostair pMDI inhalers. A video describing how to use each device can be found using the following links or pMDI QR code:
